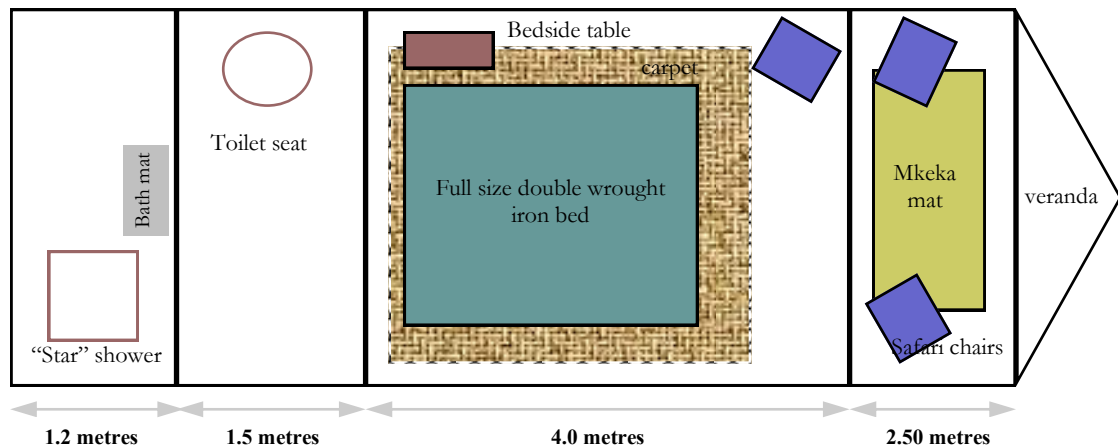


Sleeping under canvas in the African bush is a special experience. The leopard coughs in the darkness. The hyenas grunt and snarl and whoop as they prowl about. A faint flicker of rose light from the camp-fire flickers on the canvas above your head, and your heart palpitates as you hear, or think you hear the first distant throaty roar of a hunting lion. To some of us, this is the only way to experience the Serengeti and some of those special wilderness areas in Tanzania.

EASTCO has been setting up these private mobile camps in the Serengeti and remote areas of Tanzania for over 15 years and offers a portfolio of itineraries using these camps, specially sited close to the passing game.

Each camp is especially designed to ensure a minimum impact on the environment, we don't use flush toilets, as water is of such a concern throughout Tanzania, but the pit latrine and bucket "star" shower. Our aim is take as little as possible in, and leave as little as possible behind, leaving nothing to show for our experience.

- The tents used in these camps are the classic East African tents used in the golden age of safaris. These walk-in tents are 6 metres by 3 metres and come equipped with full-size stylish wrought-iron or wooden beds with six-inch mattresses and all bedding, bedside table and traditional Swahili mkeka mats or carpets on the floors.



Note: Because of the private nature of these camps, being set up for each group, each camp may vary depending on location and group size.

- Each tent has en-suite shower and toilet, with towels and soap, and complimentary drinking water is provided for cleaning of teeth etc. For couples we have large wrought iron double beds.
- The food is our specially prepared bush cuisine, cooked with fresh ingredients by our highly experienced safari chefs and served to the clients, either al fresco beneath an old baobab tree or in our custom made mess tents with full service.
- We also have our larger specially designed "honeymoon" tents which have an extra enclosed dressing room between the main bedroom and en-suite area.
- We also supply for larger groups a lounge and bar tent to relax after the days game viewing with a cold drink.
