

Oi Tukai Manyara has spectacular views across Lake Manyara towards the rift valley escarpment. Giraffe, zebras and gazelle wander along the shore amongst the distinctive palm tree which in the Masai language gives the camp its name.



Located literally on the eastern shores of Lake Manyara, **Oi Tukai Manyara** is also in the Tarangire - Manyara wildlife corridor, and the changing landscape through the year also reflects the migrating wildlife found within the camp, whilst the sunsets over the lake and the rift valley can be spectacular.

Oi Tukai Manyara offers much more than just a place to spend the night after a day game viewing in Ngorongoro en route to Arusha or Tarangire. In addition to the comforts onsite, there are walks along the lake shore, where there are thousands of birds including flamingos and pelicans and inland on the red grass plains and palm forests where giraffe, zebra and migrating wildebeest are found. Migrating elephant silently pass through the camp at night, whilst aardvark forage leaving holes scattered in the soft grey sands.

Oi Tukai Manyara is perfectly located to explore the Manyara and Tarangire ecosystems.
